## 2023 COPS Anti-Methamphetamine Program

**The COPS Anti-Methamphetamine Program (CAMP)** is a competitive award program designed to advance public safety by providing funds directly to state law enforcement agencies in states with high seizures of precursor chemicals, finished meth-amphetamine, laboratories, and laboratory dump seizures for the purpose of locating or investigating illicit activities such as precursor diversion, laboratories, or methamphetamine traffickers.

- WHEN: Deadline for first part of application in Grants.gov is April 18, 2023, at 4:59 p.m. ET. Deadline for completed application in JustGrants is April 25, 2023, at 4:59 p.m. ET.
  Start EARLY. Each of these is more than a one-day process.
- **WHERE:** 1. Register at <u>www.grants.gov</u>.
  - Complete the application in the <u>JustGrants Justice</u> Grants System.
- **HOW:** Online only. No hard copies sent by U.S. Mail or electronic copies sent via email.

## **Funding provisions**

- CAMP provides funds directly to state law enforcement agencies in states with high seizures of precursor chemicals, finished methamphetamine, laboratories, and laboratory dump seizures.
- CAMP funding must be used to locate or investigate illicit activities such as precursor diversion, laboratories, or methamphetamine traffickers.
- CAMP is open only to state law enforcement agencies authorized by law to engage in or to supervise antimethamphetamine investigative activities.
- CAMP budget requests must be at least \$1 million.

Approximately \$16 million in funding is available for 2023 CAMP. Each award is three years (36 months) in duration. Each award recipient may receive a maximum of \$2 million, and there is no local match. CAMP funding is not available for cleanup, treatment programs, or prosecution of methamphetamine-related activities. All awards are subject to the availability of appropriated funds and any modifications or additional requirements that may be imposed by law.

## How to Apply

**Step 1**. Confirm your entity's System of Award Management (SAM) registration information. Register with SAM or confirm that your SAM registration is active and accurate.

**Step 2.** Confirm that the contact information (name and email address) for your entity's electronic business point of contact (E-Biz POC) in SAM is accurate.

**Step 3.** Register with Grants.gov or confirm your existing registration.

**Step 4.** Submit the first part of your application in Grants.gov. Deadline to complete this step is **April 18, 2023**.

**Step 5**. Onboard your agency to the JustGrants Justice Grants System.

**Step 6**. Complete and submit the second part of your application in JustGrants (<u>https://justicegrants.usdoj.gov</u>).
