2024 COPS Anti-Methamphetamine Program

The COPS Anti-Methamphetamine Program (CAMP) is a competitive award program designed to advance public safety by providing funds directly to state law enforcement agencies in states with high seizures of precursor chemicals, finished methamphetamine, laboratories, and laboratory dump seizures for the purpose of locating or investigating illicit activities such as precursor diversion, laboratories, or methamphetamine traffickers.

 WHEN: Deadline for first part of application in Grants.gov is June 20, 2024, at 4:59 p.m. ET. Deadline for completed application in JustGrants is June 26, 2024, at 4:59 p.m. ET.

Start EARLY. Each of these is more than a one-day process.

- WHERE: 1. Register at www.grants.gov.
 - Complete the application in the <u>JustGrants Justice</u> <u>Grants System</u>.
- **HOW:** Online only. No hard copies sent by U.S. Mail or electronic copies sent via email.

Funding provisions

- CAMP provides funds directly to state law enforcement agencies in states with high seizures of precursor chemicals, finished methamphetamine, laboratories, and laboratory dump seizures.
- CAMP funding must be used to locate or investigate illicit activities such as precursor diversion, laboratories, or methamphetamine traffickers.
- CAMP is open only to state law enforcement agencies authorized by law to engage in or to supervise anti-methamphetamine investigative activities.
- CAMP budget requests must be at least \$1 million.

Approximately \$16 million in funding is available for 2024 CAMP. Each award is three years (36 months) in duration. Each award recipient may receive a maximum of \$2 million, and there is no cost share or matching funds requirement. CAMP funding is not available for cleanup, treatment programs, or prosecution of methamphetamine-related activities. All awards are subject to the availability of appropriated funds and any modifications or additional requirements that may be imposed by law.

How to Apply

Step 1. Confirm your entity's System of Award Management (SAM) registration information. Register with SAM or confirm that your SAM registration is active and accurate.

Step 2. Confirm that the contact information (name and email address) for your agency's electronic business point of contact (E-BIZ POC) in SAM is accurate.

Step 3. Register with Grants.gov or confirm your existing registration.

Step 4. Submit the first part of your application in Grants.gov. Deadline to complete this step is **June 20, 2024**.

Step 5. Onboard your agency to the JustGrants Justice Grants System.

Step 6. Complete and submit the second part of your application in JustGrants (<u>https//justicegrants.usdoj.gov</u>).
