Windows Media Player

Windows Media Player version 6.4, 7 or 8 is needed to view the webcast.

Real Player **

Real Player 8 or RealOne version 1 or 2 is needed to view the webcast

All Viewing Audience

If you are behind a firewall, double-check with your network administrator that port 80 is open to allow you to view the webcast.

Media Speed / Internet Connection Speed

Dialup connection audience members will need to select either 28k or 56k, depending on the modem type and quality of connection. Corporate LAN users should select 100k. Cable modem, or DSL connection members can select 100k and higher speeds.

Satellite Information:

Your satellite provider may have either C or Ku band so please use the appropriate coordinates for the satellite dish. If you are having problems with picture or sound clarity, poor weather conditions can interfere with a satellite transmission. Please plan on setting the satellite dish to the broadcast coordinates at least a half-hour prior to the beginning of the broadcast to check your signal.
