<a href="#">East Valley (Redlands, Yucaipa, Rialto, Fontana, Highland, Loma Linda, Grand Terrace, San Bernardino, Colton), California</a>	Developed in conjunction with ESRI and MoosePoint, this site provides multi-jurisdictional crime mapping for East Valley / San Bernardino region of California, as well as call-for-service and enforcement activity.

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<b>San Diego, California</b>	Developed by ARGIS (Automated Regional Justice Information Sharing), an organization that integrates local, state, and federal criminal justice and law enforcement agencies across the San Diego. The online mapping system allows users to view arrests & citations, crime incidents, along with vehicular and traffic incident data.
<b>San Francisco, California</b>	CrimeMAPS allows users to generate reports and maps of incidents. The system is based on CrimeView, from The Omega Group, and also developed by MoosePoint Technology. <i>Note: requires Internet Explorer.</i>
<b>Visalia, California</b>	Crime incident mapping

## Colorado

<b>Boulder (city), Colorado</b>	Weekly crime maps and statistics (implemented in Macromedia Flash)
<b>Boulder (county), Colorado</b>	Boulder county monthly crime maps
<b>Colorado Springs, Colorado</b>	Weekly crime maps and annual meth lab seizures maps.
<b>Longmont, Colorado</b>	Simple, yet effective, maps displaying crime locations from the past two weeks. Utilizes JavaScript, to handle the layers.

<b>Chicago, Illinois</b>	Citizen ICAM is the Chicago Police Department's official crime mapping IMS application, allowing search of up to 90 days of crime statistics, by address, police beat, intersections or schools for crime statistics.
<b>Chicago, Illinois</b>	<a href="http://www.chicagocrime.org">www.chicagocrime.org</a> , which is not-affiliated with the Chicago Police Department, integrates crime incident data with Google Maps.

## Indiana

<b>Evansville, Indiana</b>	Interactive crime mapping.
<b>Indianapolis/Marion County, Indiana</b>	Incident report mapping.

## Kansas

<b>Lenexa, Kansas</b>	Allows users to view crime information in map format for the previous 90 days, as well as tabular crime data for previous quarters.
<b>Wichita, Kansas</b>	Thematic maps displaying crime statistics, as well as the capability of viewing crime statistics by reporting area.

## Kentucky

<b>Lexington, Kentucky</b>	Citizen's Crime Watch mapping, by neighborhood, police sector, street, address, or intersection. <i>Note: Requires Internet Explorer.</i>
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## Louisiana

<b>Jefferson Parish, Louisiana</b>	Crime Tracker mapping, by zip code or neighborhood.
<b>New Orleans, Louisiana</b>	Crime maps by police district.

## Maryland

<b>Baltimore, Maryland</b>	Interactive crime mapping, as part of Baltimore's CitiStat program. <i>Note: Need to disable popup blocker.</i>
<b>Baltimore County, Maryland</b>	Community Crime Profile, an ArcIMS-based application, provides summary UCR crime statistics for Baltimore County.
<b>Prince George's County, Maryland</b>	Crime incident mapping, for past 3 months.

## Massachusetts

<b>Cambridge, Massachusetts</b>	Informative annual & quarterly neighborhood crime reports and statistics (PDF).
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## Michigan

<b>Detroit, Michigan</b>	Crime maps and neighborhood demographics for three area counties
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## Minnesota

<b>St. Paul, Minnesota</b>	Monthly choropleth crime maps provided in PDF format.
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## Missouri

<b>St. Louis, Missouri</b>	Safe City interactive crime and call for service mapping. <i>Note: Requires pop-up blocker disabled.</i>
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## Nebraska

<b>Lincoln, Nebraska</b>	CrimeView system allows users to map crime near specific locations or view summarized crime data, by crime type, time period, or by specific neighborhoods, beats, or quadrants. <i>Note: Requires Internet Explorer, with pop-up blocker disabled.</i>
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## Nevada

<b>Las Vegas, Nevada</b>	CrimeView system allows users to map crime by police districts or beats, or near specific locations. <i>Note: this works best with Internet Explorer.</i>
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## New Mexico

<b>Albuquerque, New Mexico</b>	Detailed neighborhood and beat crime statistics, along with maps depicting annual crime statistics.
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## North Carolina

<b>Charlotte-Mecklenburg, North Carolina</b>	Interactive crime incident and calls for service mapping and information (data available through November 2004).
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## Ohio

<b>Toledo, Ohio</b>	Weekly crime maps in PDF format.
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## Oklahoma

<b>Oklahoma City, Oklahoma</b>	CrimeTracker, provided by KWTW and The Oklahoman, maps crime incidents near addresses.
<b>Tulsa, Oklahoma</b>	Crime incidents, sex offenders, traffic collisions, and meth lab maps.

## Oregon

<b>Beaverton, Oregon</b>	Monthly neighborhood crime maps (PDF) and statistics.
<b>Portland, Oregon</b>	Map neighborhood Part I crimes with CrimeMapper, download neighborhood crime statistics, and view precinct maps. CrimeMapper uses choropleth (area shading) maps to display crime for the neighborhoods as a whole, rather than displaying crime as point data.

## Pennsylvania

<b>Philadelphia, Pennsylvania</b>	Philadelphia NIS CrimeBase is developed by the University of Pennsylvania's Cartographic Modeling Lab. It provides interactive choropleth mapping of Philadelphia's annual crime statistics, from 1998 - 2003.
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## Tennessee

<b>Memphis, Tennessee</b>	CrimeMapper system provides crime incident information near specific addresses or intersections.
<b>Nashville, Tennessee</b>	Interactive Crime Maps

## Texas

<b>Austin, Texas</b>	Crime Viewer map application
<b>Dallas, Texas</b>	Interactive crime mapping, through partnership with the North Central Texas Council of Governments
<b>San Antonio, Texas</b>	Map crime incidents <i>Note: must disable pop-up blocker.</i>

<b>San Antonio, Texas</b>	The San Antonio Police Department, along with the Fire Department, provides real-time traffic flow and incident maps, along with list of street closures, and fire incidents.
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## Utah

<b>Salt Lake (county), Utah</b>	Monthly and quarterly crime incident maps and call-for-service reports by area.
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## Washington

<b>Pierce (county), Washington</b>	Crime, drug, and other incident data by neighborhood or address.
<b>Snohomish (county), Washington</b>	Map of registered sex offenders
<b>Spokane, Washington</b>	Crime and drug hot spot and incident mapping.

## Wisconsin

<b>Milwaukee, Wisconsin</b>	As part of the Milwaukee COMPASS (Community Mapping and Analysis for Safety Strategies), this web application provides incident-level crime mapping, along with property, community safety, demographic, and health data to inform and empower citizens to participate in community problem solving and crime prevention.
