FY 2022 Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring Program Community Policing Development

Community Policing Development (CPD) funds are used to develop the capacity of law enforcement to implement community policing strategies by providing guidance on promising practices through the development and testing of innovative strategies; building knowledge about effective practices and outcomes; and supporting new, creative approaches to preventing crime and promoting safe communities. The CPD program will fund projects that develop knowledge, increase awareness of effective community policing strategies, increase the skills and abilities of law enforcement and community partners, increase the number of law enforcement agencies and relevant stakeholders using proven community policing practices, and institutionalize community policing practice in routine business.

WHEN:

Deadline for first part of application in Grants.gov is **June 21, 2022**, at 7:59 p.m. ET. Deadline for completed application in JustGrants is **June 23, 2022**, at 7:59 p.m. ET.

Start EARLY. This is more than a one-day process.

WHERE:

- Register online with <u>www.sam.gov</u> to obtain a Unique Entity Identifier (UEI) and <u>www.grants.gov</u> to complete the Grants.gov application package.
- Complete the application in the JustGrants Justice Grants System.

How: Online only. No hard copies sent by U.S. Mail or electronic copies sent via email.

FY22 Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring—Community Policing Development

This year's Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring CPD program has one open solicitation. This program aims to develop recruitment and hiring resources (videos, toolkits, publications, podcasts, etc.) that can be shared with the broader law enforcement field and provide technical assistance to help law enforcement agencies, in particular those funded through the COPS Hiring Program (CHP), implement improvements to increase their capacity to attract and select the best candidates and develop creative and engaging opportunities to market policing positions and expand the pool of potential applicants for their agencies.

Please see the Funding Provisions section on page 2 for additional solicitation information. All awards are subject to the availability of appropriated funds and any modifications or additional requirements that may be imposed by law.

The COPS Office is committed to advancing work that promotes civil rights and racial equity, increases access to justice, supports crime victims and individuals impacted by the justice system, strengthens community safety and protects the public from crime and evolving threats, and builds trust between law enforcement and the community.

Funding Provisions

Provisions include the following:

- This solicitation is open to for-profit (commercial) organizations, nonprofit organizations, institutions of higher education, community groups, and faith-based organizations.
- Applications should be responsive to the solicitation, significantly advance the field of community policing, and demonstrate an understanding of community policing as it pertains to the application topic. Applicants must identify specific program goals that will be directly accomplished if awarded Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring CPD funding. Detailed descriptions of eligibility and additional information are available in the individual solicitation guide.
- There is up to \$400,000 in funding available through the FY 2022 Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring CPD program. The award is two years (24 months) in length. There is no local match.

How to Apply

Applicants are first required to register online with www.sam.gov to obtain their Unique Entity Identifier and www.grants.gov to complete the Grants.gov application package. Deadline to complete this step is **June 21, 2022**. After submitting the Grants.gov application package, applicants will receive an email with instructions on completing the second part of the Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring CPD application through the JustGrants Justice Grant System.

Complete application packages for the FY 2022 Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring CPD Innovations in Recruitment and Hiring solicitation are due by **June 23, 2022**, at 7:59 p.m. ET. Before submitting your application, please review the appropriate solicitation guide and materials. Applications in hard or electronic format sent via email or U.S. Mail will not be accepted.

Please note: The COPS Office requires two authorized representatives (Law Enforcement Executive/Program Official and Government Executive/Financial Official) for its grant applications. Confirm your two authorized representatives complete the steps to create their accounts. If they do not, the delay may prevent timely submission of your application.
