2024 Safer Outcomes: Enhancing De-Escalation and Crisis Response Training for Law Enforcement Program

Safer Outcomes funds are used to promote training on de-escalation and crisis response for law enforcement officers, support personnel employed by law enforcement agencies, and mental health professionals working on crisis intervention teams as employees of a law enforcement agency or under a legal agreement with a law enforcement agency.

Supported training programs will address one or more of the following areas of focus:

- 1. De-escalation tactics and alternatives to use of force
- 2. **Safely responding** to an individual experiencing a mental or behavioral health or suicidal crisis
- 3. Safe encounters with individuals with disabilities
- 4. Successfully participating on a crisis intervention team
- 5. Making referrals to community-based services and support

The 2024 Safer Outcomes program funded projects related to the following categories:


- Expansion of Regional De-Escalation Training Centers
- Support for Law Enforcement Agencies
- Curriculum Integration for Law Enforcement Academies and State-Level Training Commissions

Funding Provisions

Provisions include the following:

- In FY 2024, the COPS Office awarded \$15,426,011 under the Safer Outcomes program.
- The Safer Outcomes program categories had individual eligibility criteria but generally were open to all state, local, tribal, and territorial law enforcement agencies; institutions of higher education and nonprofit organizations with experience providing training to law enforcement at the national or regional level; and law enforcement training academies and state-level regulatory bodies with the authority to establish training standards. Accepted proposals were responsive to the specified criteria for the program category to which they applied.
