

# ***COPS Quick Facts***

## **For the State of Alaska**

To Date, \$79,879,899 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Alaska

### **Highlights**

- COPS grants have funded 313 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Alaska.
- 110 local and state law enforcement agencies in Alaska have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$3,740,246 has been awarded to add 31 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Alaska.
- \$49,882,888 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Alaska fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
