## **For the State of Vermont**

To Date, \$32,512,750 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Vermont

### **Highlights**

- COPS grants have funded 257 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Vermont.
- 64 local and state law enforcement agencies in Vermont have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$3,490,357 has been awarded to add 30 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Vermont.
- \$11,855,923 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Vermont fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
