

# ***COPS Quick Facts***

## **For the State of Colorado**

To Date, \$119,134,318 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Colorado

### **Highlights**

- COPS grants have funded 1,310 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Colorado.
- 198 local and state law enforcement agencies in Colorado have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$10,024,710 has been awarded to add 82 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Colorado.
- \$15,411,323 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Colorado fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
