To Date, \$129,469,909 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Connecticut



- COPS grants have funded 1,366 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Connecticut.
- 126 local and state law enforcement agencies in Connecticut have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$9,000,000 has been awarded to add 72 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Connecticut.
- \$34,542,639 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Connecticut fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
