To Date, \$44,527,975 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Rhode Island



- COPS grants have funded 411 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Rhode Island.
- 46 local and state law enforcement agencies in Rhode Island have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$3,581,537 has been awarded to add 29 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Rhode Island.
- \$13,786,681 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Rhode Island fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
