To Date, \$248,159,598 in COPS grants were awarded to law enforcement agencies in the State of Washington



- COPS grants have funded 2,044 additional police officers and sheriffs deputies to engage in community policing activities, including crime prevention, in Washington.
- 257 local and state law enforcement agencies in Washington have directly benefited from funding made available through the COPS Office.
- \$11,142,787 has been awarded to add 90 school resources officers to improve safety for students, teachers, and administrators in primary and secondary schools throughout Washington.
- \$36,084,904 has been awarded for crime-fighting technologies. This funding has allowed officers to spend more time on the streets of Washington fighting and preventing crime through timesaving technology, information-sharing systems, and improved communications equipment.
