The COPS Office recently announced the availability of funding under the COPS Tribal Methamphetamine Initiative (Tribal Meth) 2010 grant program. At this time, there are two important program updates which we want to bring to your attention.

First, please be advised that, due to unforeseen circumstances, Tribal Meth applicants are unable to insert their narrative responses into the text boxes in Section 11 of the application, as previously instructed. As an alternative, please attach your agency's Project Description (Narrative, to include parts A-E) in Section 13: Application Attachments. The label for this attachment will be "Other."

Additionally, the previous July 6th Tribal Meth application deadline has been **extended to 11:59 pm E.D.T. on Monday, July 12, 2010**. The additional time will provide interested tribal agencies an opportunity to complete the narrative section as mentioned above, and finish the submission of their proposals.
