


# Mayor's Gang Prevention Task Force Leadership Structure

# Mayor's Gang Prevention Task Force


**Vision:** Safe and healthy youth connected to their families, schools, communities, and their futures.

## Partner, Coordinate, & Support County of Santa Clara Re-Entry Model




## **Strategic Goal #6: Re-Entry Focus (cont'd)**
