

Section (e)(3) of the Privacy Act of 1974, codified at 5 U.S.C. 552a, requires that the COPS Office inform users of its authority to request personal information, how the information will be used, and the effects of not providing the requested information.

Authority: The Violent Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, the Violence Against Women and Department of Justice Reauthorization Act of 2005, and E.O. 13684.

Purpose: To collect email addresses from individuals who request updates on the Presidential Task Force on 21st Century Policing, for the purpose of assisting the COPS Office in managing and responding to such requests.

Routine Use: Collected email addresses will be used by the COPS Office to provide requesting individuals updates on the Presidential Task Force on 21st Century Policing.

Disclosures: Disclosure of email addresses by individuals to the Department of Justice is voluntary. However, if the requested information is not provided the COPS Office will be unable to provide an individual email updates on task force activities.
