Allie Bones is the Chief Executive Officer of the Arizona Coalition to End Sexual and Domestic Violence. The mission of the organization is to lead, to advocate, to educate, to prevent and end sexual and domestic violence in Arizona. Throughout her career, she has held a variety of governmental and advocacy positions focusing on issues of violence against women, homelessness and hunger.
