Jim Winkler serves as President and General Secretary of the National Council of Churches of Christ in the USA, the leading ecumenical organization in the country. The NCC is an ecumenical partnership of 37 Christian faith groups in the United States. Its member denominations, churches, conventions, and archdioceses include Mainline Protestant, Orthodox, African American, Evangelical, and historic peace churches. Together, they encompass more than 100,000 local congregations and 40 million adherents.
