Susan Rahr is Executive Director of the Washington State Criminal Justice Training Commission, a position she has held since 2012. From 2005 to 2012, she served as the first female Sheriff in King County, Washington. Ms. Rahr spent over thirty years as a law enforcement officer, beginning as a patrol officer and undercover narcotics officer. While serving with the King County Sheriff's Office, she held various positions including serving as the commander of the Internal Investigations and Gang Units, commander of the Special Investigations Section, and Police Chief of Shoreline, Washington. Ms. Rahr received a B.A. from Washington State University. She has served as a member of the National Institute of Justice and Harvard Kennedy School Executive Session on Policing and Public Safety; President of the Washington State Association of Sheriffs and Police Chiefs, and an Executive Board Member of the National Sheriffs Association.
